The CIAO KIDS Foundation helps disadvantaged tribal populations in India. The Foundation's mission is to improve the quality of life of these people and protect their rights so that they can live a dignified life, without losing any of their ancestral tradition.

THE ADIVASIS

India, the country with the second largest population in the world, is characterised by immense inequalities, despite the rapid economic growth. These inequalities are further emphasized by the traditional practice of dividing society into castes. People attributed to the lowest caste, or Dalits (previously known as 'untouchables'), and aboriginal tribes make up a fifth of the population and live in extreme poverty. Today, they are still significantly lagging behind other rural communities. Their literacy rate is very low, which means that they are unable to exercise their rights.
