

OUR BENEFICIARIES

In **India**, the world's second most populous country, high levels of inequality persist despite rapid economic growth. The traditional caste system accentuates these inequalities. The "outcasts", Dalits, and the aboriginal tribes, Adivasis, represent one fifth of the population.

Nepal is not only suffering from poverty, but is also recovering from the 2015 earthquake as well as from two particularly difficult years of Covid. The aboriginal tribes, Janajatis, represent a third of its population.

These communities are still lagging far behind other rural communities. Alcoholism, illiteracy, unemployment and school failure are the direct consequences of extreme poverty.

Its mission is to improve their living conditions and to defend their rights in order to help them live a dignified and autonomous life, while respecting their ancestral traditions.



Within these two main areas, we have several programs and activities targeting the sustainable development of these communities.

During the pandemic, we supported 5'200 **people** with emergency food and medical aid.
